Marilyn Singleton, M.D, J.D. is a board-certified anesthesiologist and President of the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons, an organization that has fought against socialized medicine since 1943. She graduated from Stanford and earned her MD at UCSF Medical School. She was on the faculty at Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland before returning to California for private practice.

John Sullivan is an award-winning director, writer and producer with over \$125mm in box office performance. He has three of the top political documentaries in history with *Expelled, America* and *2016: Obama's America*. He was a producer on *Gosnell* and *Unplanned* which is still in theaters. He is the writer of *No Safe Spaces* with Dennis Prager and Adam Carolla on the attack upon free speech. *No Safe Spaces* hits theaters this fall.

Dr. Peter W. Wood is president of the National Association of Scholars. He is the author of a number of books, most recently *The Architecture of Intellectual Freedom* (2016), and the co-author of many others including *What Does Bowdoin Teach?* (2013). He is also editor-in-chief of the journal *Academic Questions* and a frequent contributor to other magazines and journals. He previously served as provost of The King's College in New York City, and as associate provost and the president's chief of staff at Boston University, where he was also a tenured member of the anthropology department.

William Voegeli is a senior editor of the Claremont Review of Books, a visiting scholar at Claremont McKenna College's Henry Salvatori Center, and the author of two books: *Never Enough: America's Limitless Welfare State* (Encounter Books, 2010); and *The Pity Party: A Mean-Spirited Diatribe Against Liberal Compassion* (Broadside Books, 2014). His work has appeared in many publications, including *City Journal*, *Commentary*, the *Los Angeles Times*, *National Review*, and the *Weekly Standard*. After receiving a doctorate in political science from Loyola University in Chicago he was a program officer for the John M. Olin Foundation.

Bill Whittle is an American conservative political commentator and YouTuber. He has made videos for PJ Media as the presenter of Afterburner and The Firewall, and as co-host of Right Angle with Stephen Green and Scott Ott, his former fellow co-hosts of Trifecta. Whittle has also produced videos and writing for other outlets, such as the NRA. He is a former National Review Online contributor and has been a guest on the Fox News Channel, The Dennis Miller Show, Sun TV, and national radio programs. His first book, *Silent America: Essays from a Democracy at War*, was published in 2004. He is also the co-founder of the independent film studio Declaration Entertainment, and is a narrator for Encounter Books.

Michael Walsh is a journalist, author, and screenwriter, whose work includes six novels, nine works of non-fiction and a hit Disney movie. The former classical music critic and foreign correspondent for Time magazine, he is now a regular contributor of political and cultural commentary to PJ Media and American Greatness, as well as a Sunday op-ed columnist for the New York Post. His most recent works are *The Devil's Pleasure Palace*, and *Fiery Angel*.

Speakers

L. Brent Bozell III is a renowned lecturer, syndicated columnist, television commentator, debater, marketer, businessman, author, publisher and activist. He is one of the most outspoken and effective national leaders in the conservative movement today. Founder and President of the Media Research Center, Mr. Bozell runs the largest media watchdog organization in America. Since its launch in 1987, the MRC has developed the largest video archive in the world, which includes the popular NewsBusters.org blog site. He founded the Conservative Victory Committee PAC in 1987. His writings have also appeared in numerous other outlets including the Wall Street Journal, the Washington Post, FoxNews.com and USA Today.

Stephen Coughlin is an attorney, decorated intelligence officer and noted specialist on Islamic law, ideology and associated issues as they relate to terrorism and subversion. In 2001, Coughlin was assigned to the Directorate for Intelligence, Joint Chiefs of Staff. In 2006, Coughlin was lead consultant to Joint Staff J2 in counterterror threat. In 2007, Coughlin was awarded a Master of Science of Strategic Intelligence from the Joint Military Intelligence College/Defense Intelligence Agency. Stephen Coughlin is a Senior Fellow at the Center for Security Policy and a Lincoln Fellow at the Claremont Institute. His book *Catastrophic Failure: Blindfolding America in the Face of Jihad* was released in 2015.

Rebecca Friedrichs is the face of a national movement to restore the voices and authority of parents and teachers in America's schools. Her seminal lawsuit, *Friedrichs v California Teachers' Association*, which sought to free educators and all public sector employees from forced unionism, was argued before the U.S. Supreme Court but the passing of Justice Scalia resulted in a deadlocked decision. To continue her fight against the destruction of our schools and values, she published *Standing Up to Goliath*, an exposé of bully unions. She also founded For Kids and Country, a national movement of parents, teachers, students, faith leaders, and citizens uniting to restore our schools and culture.

Joel Gilbert is a Hollywood film maker, foreign policy analyst, and political commentator. He has written, directed and produced documentary feature films on the Left, including *There's No Place Like Utopia* and *Dreams from My Real Father*. His other films have covered the Middle East conflict, Islamism, and Iran.

Michael Gonzalez, senior fellow at the Heritage Foundation's Kathryn and Shelby Cullom Davis Institute for International Studies, left a 20-year career in journalism to join the administration of President George W. Bush as a speechwriter. Gonzalez, who joined Heritage in 2009, writes on national identity, diversity, multiculturalism, assimilation and nationalism, as well as foreign policy in general. He has written for numerous publications including *Foreign Policy*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Forbes.com*, *The Guardian*, and many others. Gonzalez has appeared on Fox, the BBC, CNBC, NPR as well as many other networks and stations in the United States, Europe, Asia and Latin America.

Larry Greenfield is a fellow of the Claremont Institute and a frequent columnist on American politics and foreign policy. His columns currently appear at *American Greatness* and the *Jewish Journal* among other publications. Larry earned his BA at UC Berkeley and his Law Degree at the Georgetown University Law Center. He served in US Naval Intelligence Reserves and was publisher of the *Journal of International Security Affairs*. Mr. Greenfield was the founding executive director of the Reagan Legacy Foundation and serves on the American Freedom Alliance Advisory Council.

Richard Higgins is a Senior Fellow at Unconstrained Analytics. Higgins was Vice President of Intelligence & National Security for RED, LLC, a company that develops, tests and evaluates new combat capabilities for special operations, intelligence and irregular warfare missions. He is an expert on the nexus between theological doctrines and information age unconventional warfare and has spent 20 years combating terrorism. Higgins has advised the White House, Congress, and Foreign Governments on strategy, technology, and terrorism related matters. He is a 2011 Lincoln Fellow from the Claremont Institute and a US Army Veteran.

David Horowitz is one of the nation's foremost experts on the topic of the Left, their goals, tactics and strategies. He is a founder and president of the think tank the David Horowitz Freedom Center (DHFC); editor of the Center's publication, FrontPage Magazine; and director of Discover the Networks, a website that tracks individuals and groups on the political

left. Horowitz also founded the organization Students for Academic Freedom. He is the author of countless books including a nine volume opus, *The Black Book of the American Left* and his seminal autobiography, *Radical Son*. His most recent book, *Dark Agenda*, exposes the Left's undermining of our religious institutions, arguably the most important foundational element of Western Civilization itself.

Lance Izumi is Koret Senior Fellow in Education Studies and Senior Director of the Center for Education at the Pacific Research Institute, a public policy think tank based in San Francisco, Sacramento and Pasadena. He is the author of numerous studies and books; most recently, he is the author of the 2017 book *The Corrupt Classroom*, the 2018 publication *An American Education Agenda*, and the 2019 book *Choosing Diversity: How Charter Schools Promote Diverse Learning Models and Meet the Needs of Parents and Children*. A former Republican speech writer, he has also written and co-produced educational documentaries, and served on multiple public service boards.

Charlie Kirk is the Founder and President of Turning Point USA, a national student movement dedicated to identifying, organizing, and empowering young people to promote the principles of free markets and limited government. With representation on over 1,400 high schools and college campuses nationwide and over 150 fulltime staff, Turning Point USA is the largest and fastest growing conservative youth activist organization in the country. A regular on Fox News and a columnist at The Hill, Charlie is the best-selling author of "Campus Battlefield" and was the youngest speaker at the 2016 Republican National Convention. At just 25-years-old, Charlie has appeared on CNBC, Fox News and FOX Business News over 500 times and has been named to the Forbes "30 under 30" list. His social media reach is over 100 million people per month and according to Axios, he is one of the "top 5 most engaged" Twitter profiles in the world.

Trevor Loudon is an author, filmmaker, and public speaker from Christchurch New Zealand. He is the author of *Barack Obama and the Enemies Within*, and *The Enemies Within: Communists, Socialists and Progressives in the U.S. Congress*, which became the basis for the documentary *Enemies Within*, released in 2016. A Fellow of the American Freedom Alliance, Trevor is currently working with the Capital Research Center on the film series *America Under Siege*.

Barak Lurie is the managing partner of Lurie & Seltzer, focusing on real estate and business law. He's also on the board of PragerU, where he helps fight Google and Youtube against censorship of conservatives. Lurie is also a radio talk show host at AM870 here in Los Angeles, and the author of the bestseller *Atheism Kills*, about the growing destructive force of Atheism. His upcoming book, *Rise of the Sex Machines*, is due out this summer. Most importantly, he's an unapologetic lover of God, America and Israel.

Pete Peterson, dean of the Pepperdine School of Public Policy (SPP), is a leading national speaker and writer on issues related to civic participation. In 2017, SPP launched a new initiative titled the "American Project: On the Future of Conservatism," a unique effort to address the future of the conservative movement. Peterson writes for a variety major news outlets including the *Wall Street Journal*, *Los Angeles Times*, and *San Francisco Chronicle*. Peterson has been a public affairs fellow at The Hoover Institution, and he serves on the Leadership Councils of the Public Policy Institute of California and California Forward, and on the boards of the Homeland Security Advisory Council and the Da Vinci Charter Schools. Peterson was the Republican candidate for California Secretary of State in 2014.

Larry Sand is the president of the non-profit California Teachers Empowerment Network – a non-partisan, non-political group dedicated to providing teachers with reliable and balanced information about professional affiliations and positions on educational issues. In 2011, realizing that parents, taxpayers and others frequently receive faulty information from the mainstream media, CTEN expanded its mission to help the general public understand the array of educational issues facing our country today.

James Simpson is an investigative journalist, businessman and former economist and budget examiner for the White House Office of Management and Budget (OMB), under presidents Reagan, H.W. Bush and Clinton. His most recent book is *The Red Green Axis: Refugees, Immigration and the Agenda to Erase America*. Mr. Simpson is featured in a number of documentaries. His articles and research work have been published in *Accuracy in Media*, *American Thinker*, *Breitbart*, *Capital Research Center*, *Daily Caller*, *Epoch Times*, *PJ Media*, *Washington Times*, *Watchdog*, *WorldNet Daily* and elsewhere.
